About the event:

This event was divided into two sessions. In the morning session TiE Charter Member Srikanthan Tirumala gave an Introduction on Entrepreneurship and talked about his journey as an entrepreneur. He inspired students by telling that anyone with a computer and an internet connection can start his or her own business, courage and determination is all we need. He also advised everyone to have a business partner before starting a business. He then explained his journey of life as an entrepreneur, the difficulties he faced and how he overcame his obstacles. He made clear that just having an idea doesn't make one an entrepreneur but having courage and implementing their idea makes one. He explained in detail about TiE and the competitions which it conducts every year. He asked students who were aspiring to become great entrepreneurs to take part in the competitions conducted by TiE.

The morning session ended with Q & A where students raised some serious questions. One such question was about theft of ideas for which Mr. Srikanthan Tirumala answered," If your idea gets stolen be happy that you are doing right". Any successful company so far has faced several problems and the reason why they are so successful is because they did not give up and kept pushing

towards their goals. Hence, they are so successful, so keep learning from your mistakes and keep growing. Eventually you will attain success. Don't give up your idea just because competition is too high. If you are good at it keep improving it.

The session ended with a vote of thanks given by Mr. Ram Mohan.

Keynote Speech 2: Sparken Ideas, Smarten Tomorrow, Sri Charan Lakkaraju

Mr. Sricharan Lakkaraju is the CEO of Stumagz. He initiated the speech by asking the participants to ask him questions. The participants have asked questions to Mr. Sricharan, where he answered many of them. He focused on the significance of being humble in spite of the success you have seen in life. He also educated entrepreneurial enthusiasts that they should know who will buy whom so as to know whom to approach with a business idea. She has also later added that Merxius has won the Boeing HorizonX India Innovation challenge and received investment from Boeing. She also emphasized that building resources and planning ahead are vital for a start-up to sustain without which almost 95% of start-ups shut down in three years of their initial stage. She also educated the students that it is important to keep your customers in mind, implying which their company developed merxius software which can be used by anyone even if they have no knowledge on technology. She ended it beautifully by telling the audience to have a vision and keep going as one never knows when success knocks their door.

Ms Neotia also gave many examples like, Henry Ford, "who identified the need for automobiles as a faster means of transport. There was a Q&A session at the end, where the audience asked questions to which Ms Neotia answered. At the end of the day; don't be afraid to stand up or stand down", said Ms Neotia.

D.I.S.R.U.P.T: An Idea Generation Game

After a mind-boggling speech by Vaishali Neotia, this D.I.S.R.U.P.T session was conducted. This is an idea generation game. Panel Discussion 1: Don't 'think' the idea; rather 'use' the idea





Report On STARTUP PRAYANAM

Visit to ALEAP industrial estate:

We started at VASAVI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING at 10:00 am. According to the schedule, we reached ALEAP industrial estate by 11:20. We were received by one of the manager of ALEAP industrial estate Miss. Deepthi Manchu garu. ALEAP is established in the year 1993 and is serving as platform for many lady entrepreneurs to develop their skills in various areas of industry and start their own business. We are taken to jute factory where bags were jute and dresses for small children aging between two years to six years were also made in the factory. They all are working under the program called VANDE MATARAM started by the Prime Minister of India Dr. Narendra modi. This program is to help women to become successful entrepreneurs in textile industry. They are provided with mentors who help them in making bags. The training program is about two months long. After the visit around the factory, we had an interactive session for about one hour with one of the founders of ALEAP Miss. Rama Devi garu. We all were given suggestions by Rama devi garu about how to make a skill

development program to benefit all the entrepreneurs. We heard many successful stories about women who have come to ALEAP and started their own enterprise and are running successfully. We all are inspired by the success stories of women entrepreneurs and we all shall move in the light of entrepreneurship.

Visit to T-HUB:

After departing from ALEAP industrial estate we reached T-HUB by around 2:30 pm. Telangana government's plans to make Hyderabad as the start-up capital of India got a major fillip with laying of foundation for technology incubation centre 'T-Hub' at the International Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) premises in Gachibowli. This facility, aimed at promoting entrepreneurship besides developing start-up ecosystem, will be operational by June.

The T-Hub is being set up in collaboration with IIIT Hyderabad, the Indian School of Business (ISB) and the NALSAR University of Law. While NALSAR would help in intellectual property and related areas, ISB and IIIT would provide business mentoring and technology mentoring respectively. The first phase coming up at IIIT at a cost of Rs 35 crore will be spread over 60,000 square feet and can accommodate 400 start-ups by 2017.

In the second phase, to commence from 2017 onwards, the centre would have its own campus of over 300,000 square feet. To be built at an estimated cost of Rs.200 crore, the campus will house various stakeholders like start-ups, investors and service provider.

Those who have an idea of starting a startup, they must in the site and if it is accepted by the jury members, they can start their own business and can be mentored by senior members from industry. After a tour of t hub, we had an interactive session with one of the startups in T-HUB lead by Ajith. They all have an eco-system which provides bidding entrepreneurs to have interaction with various well established companies. So we all have known about, how T-HUB works for the development of India as a super power.

Then we returned to college around 4:30pm.
