

Report on the online Meet conducted on "Problem Plethora" on 3rd April 2021 by IIC and ED-Cell, VCE, Hyderabad.

Problem Plethora was a competition conducted by Swayam. The main aim of this competition was to help participants understand the importance of identifying problems and to improve the ability to validate and find out which problems are worth solving since people often end up looking for nice-to-have solutions instead of identifying must-solve problems. The competition was held online and was judged by three esteemed judges: Ganesh Rayala sir, director and head of academic programs of T-Hub Hyderabad, Sushmitha Sundhar ma'am, Program Manager at Indian School of Business and Amit Singh sir, Senior Regional Manager of Nextgen Program at Wadhvani Foundation.

The 29 participating teams (83 participants) had come up with pressing problems and creative approaches to them trying to prove and persuade why their problem is an important one.
