 young students to showcase what they had learnt and how they
 implemented it. Projects like Syringe-Based-Crane and Cycle-Chain-DrivenPumps were few of the exceptional projects presented by the students.
- Many children had several interests but did not know what fields of study would cater to these interests. Hence, career-counselling sessions were
