Prof. S.V. Ramana, the Principal and the Chairperson of the IQAC extended warm welcome to all the members. The agenda and notes on agenda items were circulated to members earlier in advance. The agenda points were taken up for the consideration:

1. Confirmation and action taken report of the minutes of the 12th IQAC Meeting held on 19.01.2019.

The minutes of the 12th meeting of IQAC held on 19th January, 2019 were circulated to the members for their suggestions. The minutes of the meeting were read and approved.

The action taken report on the resolutions made in the 12th IQAC meeting held on 27.06.2018 is given below:

Also, HoDs have suggested to faculty to get suggestions from senior scientists of DST, DRDO, DMRL, RCI and other reputed organizations to refine their research proposals.</p>

2. Introduction of "*Digital Smart Boards*" in the class rooms to enhance the quality of teaching.

It is resolved to introduce smart boards by converting some of the class rooms into digital smart class rooms to improve the Teaching-Learning Process and enhance the understanding levels of the students for critical topics in various subjects.

Principal informed the members that In response to the notification issued by NPIU-MHRD to provide infrastructure to setup digital interactive boards to TEQIP-II as well as TEQIP-III institutions through project funds to promote flipped or blended learning through digital pedagogy in technical education, the college has submitted its proposal.

The scheme is targeted for setting up multiple digital classrooms (interactive teaching device with appropriate learning resources) and training of minimum 10 faculty members from each of the selected institutions.

Principal informed to the members that the college has applied for "Local Chapter of SWAYAM-NPTEL". Many of the students as well as faculty members are appearing for MOOCS courses offered by NPTEL under SWAYAM-NPTEL initiative.

One of the student member of IQAC suggested to introduce online submission of examinations forms by the college.

3. Discussion on Quality Improvement Programmes for the students and the faculty members:

Principal informed the members that the Quality of teaching by the faculty members and quality of learning by the students can be upgraded by conducting special programmes like, training, improving pedagogical aspects and making availability of content resources either online or off-line. It is decided to depute the Faculty members to pedagogical training programs and encouraged to complete online MOOCS through SWAYM-NPTEL, EdX or Course Era platforms.

Sri Anjaneya Prasad suggested to take feedback from the stake holders periodically with a good sample size.

Sri Ravi Katakam suggested to introduce multidisciplinary courses and projects on energy technologies along with Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and innovations.

The following suggestion have been given by the members on improving the quality of teaching and learning:

1. Students are required to take up mini projects from IV semester and strengthen their theoretical concepts.
2. Students shall be advised properly by the mentors/proctors on selection of open electives, professional electives and advanced technical skills.
3. Involve the students in real time projects.
4. Students shall be advised to take MOOCS courses in the contemporary courses of their domain area.
5. Faculty members shall be advised to do MOOCS courses on latest subjects offered by various IIT professors through NPTEL-SWAYAM.
6. Encourage the faculty to publish research papers in good journals and to send proposal for funded research projects.

4. Introduction of *Virtual Labs* (online) to enable the students to practice and understand the concepts in better way.

The Principal informed the members that Virtual labs concept has been promoted by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under the National Mission on Education through ICT involving many IITs, IIIT-H, NITs and other centers of excellences.

It is also informed that our college has been allotted as nodal center by IIIT, Hyderabad and in the year 2017-18 received the Best coordinator award.

It is suggested to introduce at least one or two experiments from Virtual Labs in the curriculum in each semester to strengthen the concepts. The principal advised the Heads of the Departments to include the experiments from the list Virtual Labs in the curriculum as the departments are going to organize their Board of studies meetings soon to finalized the curriculum for the year 2019-20. The principal also informed the members that there is proposal to allot credits to the courses successfully completed by the students according to the requirements of individual departments.

5. Organizing *External Audit* on academic practices implemented by the college

The Principal informed to the members that the college is proposing to conduct External Academic Auditing which helps to identify not only the internal strengths but also to focus on the improvement through identifying the lapses. The college is already conducting internal auditing of question papers and external auditing of selected question papers. It is now proposed to conduct external auditing on certain academic and administrative practices and procedures being implemented after the college was granted autonomous status. The external audit will be conducted during 13-14 May 2019 in all the Departments.

Mr. Ravi K suggested to introduce digital Governance in the college to strengthen the existing procedures and easy data retrieval.

6. *Gap Analysis* in Teaching Learning Process and proposals for further improvement.

The principal informed to the members that, college is planning to conduct SWOC analysis in the college to identify gaps between expectations of students, their experiences at the end of programme and to meet the requirements of potential employers or the industry. Based on the SWOC analysis, the strategic planning for quality enhancement teaching learning process will be revised.

7. Introduction of Theory-cum-lab courses to support activity-based learning.

The principal informed to the members that, Theory-cum-Lab courses will be introduced to expose the students to various theoretical aspects when an experiment is being performed. Such courses provide hands-on experience to the students and an opportunity to critically analyze the given problem or task.

8. Enhancement of research publications in referred journals and to obtain research Grants from the Government funding agencies.

The principal briefly explained the status of research activities that are taken up.

- The Departments of ECE and Mechanical Engineering together has been award DST-FIST project on bio-medical implants and 5th generation Networks worth of Rs. 60 lakhs.
- Department of information Technology has been selected under MODRABS of AICTE Research and granted a funding worth of Rs. 34 lakhs.
- Research projects of worth Rs. 7.94 crores have been submitted by the faculty members to various funding agencies viz DRDO, MNRD, DST and AICTE in the Academic Year 2018-19.

9. Any other item with the permission of the chair

- (a) The Principal informed that the college is proposing to conduct GREEN AUDIT in the campus for systematic identification, quantification, recording, reporting and analysis of components of **environmental** diversity in the month of July/August, 2019.
- (b) The Principal informed the result analysis of odd Semester B.E, M.E.M.Tech and MCA programmes for the year 2018-19. Members advised to work on change the mind set of students to further improve their performance in the examination, especially mechanical and civil engineering branches.
- (c) The Principal informed to the members that the college has uploaded NAAC-IIQA on 20.04.2019 and also informed that the NAAC-SSR will be uploaded probably on or before 22.05.2019.
- (d) Mr. Ravi.K, Member suggested to prepare a vision document for the digitalization of college activities for the next 5 years. He suggested to inculcate research blend/innovation mind set in the students.
- (e) The Principal circulated to the members the documents related to (i) R&D rules and regulations (ii) policy on plagiarism and (iii) policy on consultancy. The members deliberated on the documents and approved.
- (f) Prof. Venkata Krishna, Department of IT, suggested to identify central office to collect and preserve the documents and other necessary information on various activities/events conducted in the college so that these documents can be retrieved for various expert committee visits such as NBA, NAAC, UGC, OU etc.
