3. "Guru Dakshata Program" (an Orientation Programme towards VCE Regulations, college Procedures etc.) for the newly joined faculty:

It was resolved that an Orientation Programme viz., "Guru Dakshata Program", will be conducted for the newly joined faculty to create awareness on VCE Regulations, College Procedures etc., besides covering the aspects of Teaching- Learning, effective use of Teaching Tools, New Pedagogical methods, Service Rules, Roles & Responsibilities of the faculty, evaluation/Assessment methodology, R & D activities etc.

Further resolved that one of the Departments has to organize "Guru Dakshata Program" on rotation basis in every year.

4. Finalization of modalities towards the conduct of One Day Workshop on "Time Management" to all the faculty members:

The Chairman informed that, it has been decided to conduct 1-Day Workshop on "Time Management" for all the members of faculty enabling them for effective utilization of time towards teaching learning process, to carryout R & D activities etc.,. In this connection, Dr. P. Mastanaiah and Mr. C.S. Rohith have suggested to invite suitable resource persons from Engineering Staff College of India, Hyderabad for this purpose.

5. Review of the status of updation of course files, Lab files, Personal files and all other NBA/NAAC related files for the academic year 2021-22 and Odd Semester of 2022-23:

The Chairman advised that the Departments are required to review the status of updation of Course Files, Lab Files, Personal Files and all other NBA/NAAC related files for the academic year 2021-22 and Odd-Semester of 2022-23 through an Internal Audit Committee to be constituted before the conduct of Academic Audit with external members.

6. Review of the modalities towards the conduct of Academic Audit for the academic year 2022-23:

The Chairman informed that the Academic Audit for the current year will be conducted in the month of February/March, 2023.

7. Review of the status of the Research paper publications & Patents by the faculty for the calendar year 2022:

The Chairman informed that the targets were fixed for each Department towards publication of Research papers, Patents, obtaining Funded Research Projects & Consultancy. It is observed that there is a slight improvement in the above said aspects during the calendar year 2022 compared to 2021.

8. Multidisciplinary projects for B.E- VII Semester from the academic year 2022-23:

The Chairman informed that it is resolved to introduce two multidisciplinary projects for each section of B.E- VII Semester students with effect from the academic year 2022-23. Also the Chairman advised the Departments to submit one multidisciplinary project by the faculty for funding from the Government/Private Agencies.

9. Review of the status of NAAC-AQAR submission for the academic year 2021-22:

The Chairman informed that following are the timelines fixed for submission of NAAC-AQAR for the academic year 2021-22:

- First review on 12th & 13th December, 2022.
- Second review on 16th December, 2022.
- Final review on 20th December, 2022.
- Submission of AQAR in the NAAC Portal on 27th December, 2022.

10. Other item(s):

The Principal informed the members that the draft copy of the NAAC AQAR-2021-22 is reviewed and approved by the Academic Council. It will be submitted to the NAAC on or before 31.12.2022.

He also informed that vide notification dated 23.03.2022, the NAAC authorities informed the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to submit the Institute's preparedness for NEP 2020, in the prescribed questionnaire format, as a part of AQAR. In this regard, the Osmania University nominee members on the Academic Council suggested to submit a representation to the Osmania University with a copy to the TSCHE/Government of Telangana requesting for the guidelines on the implementation of NEP 2020 by the autonomous colleges. Accordingly, the College has submitted its representation to the Osmania University, Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE) and Government of Telangana on 8th December, 2022.
